Every summer, college students from Ireland arrive in the United States to spend their summer living and working, while gaining valuable cultural experiences. The Irish International Immigrant Center helps these young people who travel to Boston by providing a Cyber Café - a safe resource center for assistance with any issues or queries. It can be used to communicate with home and to research accommodation, obtaining a Social Security number and social activities. The Cyber Café is fully staffed by the IIIC, who offer useful orientation sessions in partnership with local employers and on-site assistance.
